On-line Card Catalog

All patrons can access our card catalog via our website and check to see if we have a book in our collection with just a few simple steps.

- Go to www.wpatlibrary.org
- Click on the "Catalog Search" link
- Use the drop down menu to refine your search by word/phrase, title, author, subject, etc.

What do I do if my library does not have the book?

Simple! Just Click on the drop down menu where our library name appears, scroll up and choose ALL. The program will now search every library in PalsPlus (Passaic County Library System.) If you find the materials you are looking for, simply place a hold on the item using your library card number and PIN number. We will call you when your materials are delivered. Just call us if you need help!
